Thank you for your prompt response to our letter.

To clarify our previous correspondence, we would be very happy to meet with you, but felt a meeting would be more productive if you were willing to provide information on the specific efforts you have taken to meet your commitments under the ETI in advance of a meeting. Our objective is to make any meeting a constructive one.

We would particularly welcome an opportunity to discuss in detail the extent to which the ETI code of conduct is influencing Primark's purchasing policies and relationships with suppliers. We do not have any evidence of progress in this area, and the information Primark has made publicly available through its website fails to address the issue.

Rather than trying to set up a meeting by letter, may I suggest that you give me a call later this week to find a date and a place that is convenient to both of us.
