So that you know what to expect from People & Planet and feel safe using this online learning course, please read the following statements. If you agree with them click on 'I agree' and you can sign on to the course. 1. Using your blog

- Blogs are great things and we want you to use yours and comment on other people's posts as much as possible. However, if blogs are used to abuse or bully others you will be blocked from using the course immediately.
- Anything that you say in your blog is your own personal opinion as an individual and does not reflect the opinion of People & Planet and our members. You are fully responsible for the content that you post.
- How you write things on your blog is important; people from all over may be reading it. If you use inappropriate language we will delete your post and may block you from the course.
- People & Planet is interested in what you have to say. By posting you agree that your comments may be republished by People & Planet online and in print.
- We will delete any posts that we deem, to be commercial, offensive or in breach of the law.
- If you use other people's web content in part or in whole please make sure you have their written consent or that it was published under a creative commons license and that you include a link to the original.

2. Your privacy

People & Planet will not give your contact details to anyone else.

Your blog postings, including your chosen user name, will be publicly viewable on the web.

The answers you give to the equal opportunities form and the questions regarding your views about the world will remain strictly confidential.

The contact details that you have given us should be correct at the time of giving them.

You must be a student or a teacher.



3. Finishing the course

You will no longer be able to access the course or your blogs after the 21 March 2010.

In order to receive your course completion certificate you will need to complete the equal opportunities form, the questions about your views on the world twice (at the beginning and the end of the course) and all five weeks of activities by the 21 March 2010.
